2 1L and 2L Years

- Professional development and judicial clerkship workshops with **the Cutting Sign program at the University of Utah**
- Three-day PLSI Judicial Clerkship Workshops
- Additional sharing of the **PLSI Judicial Clerkship Handbook**
- **Fall webinar**, moderated by the **PLSI Judicial Clerkship Committee (JCC)**, with Native federal judges discussing clerkships and paths to the bench
- Outreach regarding applications for specific judges

3 2L and 3L

4 3L Year
